Rules of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle:

1. The lottery will take place online only with ticket sales ceasing at 11:59 pm the day before the scheduled draw date.
2. All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
3. Purchasers must be in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase. Raffle will be marketed within UWEO specific catchment area, namely City of Ottawa and the counties of Lanark, Renfrew and Prescott-Russell.
4. Purchasers must be an employee of (or under contract with) a Canadian Government department, agency or crown corporation including National Defence and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. Purchaser must complete a declaration at time of ticket purchase confirming they meet this eligibility requirement.
5. Tickets are 5 for \$10; 20 for \$20 and 80 for \$40
6. Tickets will be available online at <https://uweogovraffle.5050central.com>
note: this URL will be for the ticket selling microsite, no public facing website shall be used to advertise the lotteries.
7. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by ASCENDFS Canada Ltd.
8. After buying, patrons will receive a confirmation email with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
9. The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw.
10. The amount of the 50/50 will be posted on the lottery website.
11. The winning number will be announced/posted on <https://gcwcc-ccmtgc.org/en/ncr-50-50/>, <https://uweogovraffle.5050central.com/Home/Winners> and through communications to GCWCC Campaign Leaders.

12. The winner may claim their prize by contacting *United Way East Ontario/GCWCC*, by either the toll-free line at 1-877-379-6070 or 613-683-3824, or by email at: gcwcc@unitedwayeo.ca. The ticket may then be brought to *363 Coventry Road, Ottawa, Ontario* at an agreed upon time for ticket verification or using an online meeting platform such as MS Teams or Zoom. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies.
13. The winner must provide his/her name, address, and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet.
14. Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be paid by cheque or EFT (electronic funds transfer) for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
15. In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning number will be held for 6 months. After that time has elapsed the prize will be donated to a charity that United Way East Ontario provides funding to, with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
16. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draws:
 - Individuals who do not meet #2, 3 and 4 above;
 - Board member, principal officer or paid employee of United Way East Ontario;
 - Board member, principal officer or paid employee of any other United Way location in Canada; and
 - Any member of the federal GCWCC National Cabinet and Youth Council.
