United Way East Ontario (UWEO)

Rules of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle Licence #RAF1430356:

1. The lottery will take place online only with ticket sales ceasing at 11:59 pm the day before the scheduled draw date.
2. Tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
3. Purchasers must be in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase.
4. Raffle will be marketed within UWEO specific catchment area, namely the city of Ottawa and the counties of Lanark, Renfrew, and Prescott-Russell.
5. To be eligible to win, all purchasers must be an employee of (or under contract with), or pensioner of, a Canadian Government department, agency or crown corporation including National Defence and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. Purchasers must complete a declaration at time of ticket purchase confirming they meet this eligibility requirement.
6. Tickets are 5 for \$10; 30 for \$20 and 125 for \$50
7. Tickets will be available online at <https://uweo5050gov.ca>.
8. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by ASCENDFS Canada Ltd.
9. After buying, patrons will receive a confirmation email with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
10. The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw.
11. The amount of the 50/50 prize will be posted on the lottery website.
12. The winning number will be posted on the lottery website and through communications to GCWCC Campaign Leaders in the Departments/Agencies/Crown Corporations.

13. The winner may claim their prize by contacting United Way East Ontario/GCWCC, by email at: gcwcc@unitedwayeo.ca.
14. The winner must provide proof that that meet the eligibility requirements, by providing:
 - government issued identification, with photo, that confirms their identity, name and age (driver's licence, passport)
 - they are a federal government employee/contractor (Government of Canada issued ID card or security pass, with photo) or pensioner (document from the Pension Office with their name)
15. Once the winner is verified, they will be paid by EFT (electronic funds transfer) for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide the required proof of eligibility (as per #14 above), then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided (maximum 6 months). If after 6 months eligibility can not be confirmed, the draw will be declared to have no winner.
16. If no winner comes forward, the winning number will be held for 6 months. After that time has elapsed the prize will be donated to a charity that United Way East Ontario provides funding to, with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
17. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draws:
 - Individuals who do not meet #2, 3 and 5 above;
 - Board member, principal officer or paid employee of United Way East Ontario;
 - Board member, principal officer or paid employee of any other United Way Centraide location in Canada;
 - Board member, principal officer or paid employee of HealthPartners; and
 - Any member of the federal GCWCC National Cabinet or Youth Council.
